1. Installing the Software



- 1. Insert the scanner software CD in the CD-ROM drive.
- 2. The EPSON Installation Program dialog box appears. Select your preferred language and click



Note:

If the EPSON Installation Program dialog box does not appear, double-click the My Computer icon. Click the CD-ROM icon, then select Open from the File menu. Then double-click Setup.exe.

- 4. Make sure all the software in the list is selected and click OK.
- 5. Then, follow the on-screen instructions until all the software is installed. When a message appears informing you that installation is complete, click OK.

Installing application software

To install Adobe[®] Photoshop[®] Elements, insert the CD in the CD-ROM drive and then follow the on-screen instructions.

Note:

If the CD does not launch automatically, double-click the My Computer icon. Double-click the CD-ROM icon, and then double-click Setup.exe in the Adobe Photoshop Elements folder.

This completes the scanner software installation. Next, set up the scanner as described in "2. Setting up the Scanner".

- 1. Insert the scanner software CD in the CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Double-click your preferred language icon in the EPSON folder.

If the EPSON folder does not appear on your desktop, double-click the EPSON icon on your desktop.

3. Double-click the Installer icon.



- 4. The Installer dialog box appears. Be sure to install all the software in the list.
- 5. Click Start and follow the on-screen instructions. When you are finished with the installer, your computer will restart automatically.
- 6. After your computer restarts, you must install TextBridge[®] Pro. Double-click your preferred language icon again.
- 7. Double-click the TextBridge Pro Installer icon, then follow the on-screen instructions.

Installing application software

Follow the steps below to install Adobe Photoshop Elements.

- 1. Insert the CD in the CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Double-click the Install Photoshop Elements icon in the Adobe Photoshop Elements folder in the folder of your preferred language.

2. Setting up the Scanner

1. Unlock and plug in the scanner

- Turn the transportation lock to the unlocked position using a coin or similar disc.
- 2. Connect the integrated TPU connector to the scanner's option interface connector



3. Connect the power cord to the AC inlet and plug the other end into an electrical outlet.



It is not possible to change the scanner's voltage. If the label on the back of the scanner does not show the correct voltage for your country, contact your dealer. Do not plug in the power cord.

- 4. Open the integrated TPU so you can see the startup operation.
- 5. Turn on the scanner by pressing the ⁽¹⁾ Operate button. The Indicator light starts flashing.
- 6. Make sure the carriage moves slightly and the fluorescent lamp on the carriage turns on.



- 7. The Indicator light stays on in green, meaning the scanner has completed its initialization.
- If the scanner does not work as described, see the reverse side.
- Caution:

Whenever you turn off the scanner, wait at least 10 seconds before turning it back on. Rapidly turning the scanner on and off can damage it.

The scanner turns off the fluorescent lamp if it does not receive any commands from the computer within 15 minutes.

2. Connect the scanner

1. Connect one end of the cable to a suitable port on the back of the scanner, as shown below.



- 2. Connect the other end of the cable to a suitable port on your computer.
- 3. The scanner is recognized automatically. For Windows users, the dialog box appears during the recognition in progress.

Now you are ready to use your scanner.

Note for Windows 2000 users: When you connect the scanner, the following dialog box appears. Click Yes.



3. Check the installation and the setup

Follow these steps to make sure the installation and the setup are completed properly, and the scanner operates correctly.

1. Press the 🖉 Start button on the scanner.



2. If the EPSON Smart Panel window appears, your scanner is now set up and ready to use.

When using the scanner

- □ Do not place the scanner on an unstable surface, near a radiator or heat source.

- Do not let the power cord become damaged or frayed.
- □ If you plan to use the scanner in Germany, observe the following:

To provide adequate short-circuit protection and over-current protection for this scanner, the building installation must be protected by a 10 or 16 amp circuit breaker.

When choosing a place for the scanner

- Place the scanner close enough to the computer for the interface cable to reach it easily.
- Place the scanner near an electrical outlet where the power cord can be easily unplugged.
- Allow space behind the scanner for the cables, and space above the scanner so that you can raise the integrated TPU fully.
- Keep the scanner away from high temperatures, humidity and excessive dirt or dust. Also avoid using or storing the scanner in places subject to rapid changes of temperature and humidity.
- Given the scanner away from direct sunlight and strong light sources.
- □ Avoid places subject to shocks and vibrations.

- 1. Disconnect the power cord and the interface cable from the scanner.
- 2. Follow the steps described on the reverse side.

For Windows 2000 users

- 1. Make sure your scanner is turned on and connected to your PC.
- 2. Right-click the My Computer icon, and then click Properties.
- 3. In the System Properties dialog box, select the **Hardware** tab and then click **Device Manager**.
- 4. Click the plus (+) sign next to Other devices or Imaging devices. If your scanner appears under Other devices with a question (?) mark or under Imaging devices with an exclamation (!) mark, right-click your scanner name, and then select **Uninstall...**.
