


Cautions

- ☐ Remove all media from the printer before proceeding.
- ☐ Do not touch belts, circuit boards, or any other parts except those that you are cleaning. Failure to observe this precaution could affect print quality or cause malfunction.
- ☐ Use only the supplied cleaning sticks (C13S090013). Lint from other products could damage the print head.
- ☐ Once cleaning has begun, do not pause until the operation is complete. Failure to observe this precaution could damage the print head.
- ☐ he printer display language can be changed using the Language option in the Preferences menu.

Cleaning


After confirming that there is no paper in the printer and the following message is displayed, press the ▶ button to view the menus.



- Highlight Administrator Menu using the ▼ and ▲ buttons and press ▶.
- Highlight White Cap Cleaning using the ▼ and ▲ buttons and press ▶.
- Press OK to move the print head into position for cleaning.


 Wait until the message "Please wait." clears from the display.

After confirming that the message is no longer displayed, open the printer cover.



Find the caps at the right side of the platen and use a dry cleaning stick to wipe the interiors of all five caps.

Continue until no damp spots are left.



7 Close the printer cover when cleaning is complete.

The print head will return to its normal position and the message shown in Step 1 will be displayed.
